

September 5: Live for What Lasts

Read Matthew 6:19–20.

- Pastor Sarah said, “**Be careful that you have not misused your freedom in Christ.**” What does this statement mean to you?
- What are you investing your life in? Which treasures will last forever?
- How does eternity change your definition of success?
- What legacy do you want to leave? How can you store up treasure in heaven this week?

Prayer: *Pray that God will help you value eternal treasures above temporary success. Ask Him to shape your heart so that your choices, priorities, and investments reflect what matters most to Him.*

September 6: For Such a Time as This

Read Esther 4:14.

- Like Esther, God chose your generation, your gifts, and your opportunities with purpose. You are not alive by accident. Where has God positioned you to influence others? How can you serve God's purpose in this season?
- What opportunity requires courage from you?
- How has God uniquely equipped you for this moment?
- What step of faith is He asking you to take today?

Prayer: *Thank God for placing you where you are for His purpose. Ask Him for courage to seize every opportunity He gives you and to fulfill the assignment He has entrusted to your life faithfully.*

Here is a Daily Devotional to enable you to make the most out of this sermon. You may use it for your personal growth or discuss it together in your Life Group.

August 31: Made for Eternity

Read Ecclesiastes 3:11.

- What spoke to you the most from the sermon “**MADE FOR MORE THAN THIS MOMENT**”? How would what you heard impact the rest of your year?
- Every human heart longs for something that lasts because God created us with eternity in mind. What occupies most of your thoughts each day?
- How does knowing God has placed eternity in your heart change your priorities? What temporary pursuits are competing with God's eternal purpose?
- What eternal investment can you make today? How can you intentionally live for God's glory this week?

Prayer: *“Heavenly Father, help me live with eternity in view. Align my heart with Your purpose as You teach me to invest my life in what will last forever. In Jesus’ name I pray. Amen.”*

September 1: Guard Your Heart

Read 1 Timothy 4:16.

- Pastor Sarah reminded us to **“Be careful that you are not double-minded in your faith.”** What does this statement mean to you?
- What influences your decisions the most? Are you living to please God or people?
- Is there any compromise you need to surrender today? What habits help you guard your heart? How can you strengthen your walk with God this week?
- Guard your heart carefully because the condition of your heart will eventually shape the direction of your life.

Prayer: *Ask the Lord to search your heart and reveal anything that is drawing you away from Him. Pray for the grace to walk in integrity, resist compromise, and remain faithful to His truth each day.*

September 2: Walk in God's Wisdom

Read Romans 12:2.

- God never intended us to navigate life by human wisdom alone. Living wisely means trusting that God's thoughts are higher than ours.
- What decisions are you currently seeking God's wisdom for? How does God's Word shape your thinking?
- Where are you tempted to rely on your own understanding?
- Pastor Sarah shared with us, **“Be careful that you are not living to please people.”** What does walking wisely look like today? How can you grow in discerning God's will?

Prayer: *Pray that God will renew your mind through His Word and give you wisdom for every decision you face. Ask Him to help you trust His ways above your own and walk confidently in His perfect will.*

September 3: Yield to the Potter

Read Jeremiah 18:6.

- We are called to live a life fully surrendered to God. God, the Master Potter, sees what we cannot see and lovingly shapes our lives according to His purpose. What is God shaping in your character today?
- Is there an area of your life you are struggling to surrender?
- Why can you trust the Potter's hands? How has God used difficult seasons to grow you?
- What would complete surrender look like for you?

Make this declaration in faith: *“I am in the Potter's hands. I trust God's process because He is shaping me according to His perfect purpose.”*

September 4: Redeem Every Opportunity

Read Ephesians 5:16.

- The moments that seem ordinary today may become the defining moments of tomorrow. What opportunity has God placed before you today?
- How are you using your time to honor Him?
- What distractions are keeping you from God's priorities? How can you serve someone this week?
- What opportunity do you not want to miss?

Prayer: *Don't waste the opportunities God has entrusted to you. Ask God to open your eyes to the opportunities He has placed before you today. Pray for the wisdom to use your time, gifts, and influence faithfully so that your life will bear fruit for His Kingdom.*
