3 ways to live for more than this moment

1. Live Carefully.

Ephesians 5:15 “Be very careful, then, how you live...”

Be careful that you are not double-minded in your faith.

1 Kings 18:21 “Elijah went before the people and said, ‘How long will you waver between two opinions? If the LORD is God, follow Him; but if Baal is God, follow him.’”

Be careful that you are not living to please people.

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Galatians 1:10 “If I were still trying to please people, I would not be a servant of Christ.”

Judges 16:20 “He did not know that the LORD had left him.”

Be careful that you have not misused your freedom in Christ.

1 Corinthians 10:23-24 “I have the right to do anything,’ you say—but not everything is beneficial. ‘I have the right to do anything’—but not everything is constructive. No one should seek their own good, but the good of others.”

1 Timothy 4:16 “Watch your life and doctrine closely. Persevere in them, because if you do, you will save both yourself and your hearers.”

2. Walk Wisely.
