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Philippians 2:3–5 “Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others. Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus.”

Maturity is measured by how much we think about others rather than ourselves.

THREE IMPORTANT REASONS WHY YOU ARE MADE FOR MORE THAN YOURSELF

1. YOUR LIFE EXISTS TO SERVE GOD’S PURPOSE, NOT JUST YOUR PERSONAL DREAMS.

“Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit”

Our lives become meaningful only when they are surrendered to God’s assignment.

Ephesians 2:10 “For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.”

Jeremiah 1:5 “Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, and before you were born I consecrated you; I appointed you a prophet to the nations.”

Acts 13:36 “For David, after he had served the purpose of God in his own generation, fell asleep and was laid with his fathers and saw corruption.”

Romans 12:1 “I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship.”

A purpose-driven believer always becomes a blessing.

2. GREATNESS IN GOD’S KINGDOM IS MEASURED BY SERVICE.

“...but in humility count others more significant than yourselves.”

Mark 10:42–45 “... ‘You know that those who are considered rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and their great ones exercise authority over them. But it shall not be so among you. But whoever would be great among you must be your servant, and whoever would be first among you must be slave of all...”

Jesus could have demanded a throne. Instead, He carried a cross. Real greatness serves.

John 13:12–17 “When He had washed their feet...He said to them, ‘Do you understand what I have done to you? You call me Teacher and Lord, and you are right, for so I am. If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another’s feet...a servant is not greater than his master, nor is a messenger greater than the one who sent him. If you know these things, blessed are you if you do them.’”

The King performed the work of the lowest servant. Leadership is not demonstrated by how many people serve you. Leadership is demonstrated by how many people you serve.

Galatians 5:13 “Through love serve one another.”

Freedom is not permission to live selfishly. Freedom is the opportunity to bless others.

Love always serves. Selfishness always demands.

1 Peter 4:10 “As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another.”

Every spiritual gift is given for ministry. Your gift is never for self-promotion.

It is for Kingdom impact.

The happiest believers are usually the busiest servants. Serving expands your capacity for God’s blessing.

3. WHEN YOU LIVE FOR OTHERS, GOD MULTIPLIES YOUR IMPACT.

“Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others. Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus.”

Genesis 12:2–3 “And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.”

God never intended blessings to terminate with you. You are a channel, not a reservoir.
