GOD'S PROMISE FOR YOUR PROVISION

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Three Elements of God's Promise for Your Provision

1. The PREMISE.

Philippians 4:15-16 “As you know, you Philippians were the only ones who gave me financial help when I first brought you the Good News and then traveled on from Macedonia. No other church did this. Even when I was in Thessalonica you sent help more than once.”

The premise for God's promise for your provision is giving.

Isaiah 55:8 “For My thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways My ways,’ declares the LORD.”

Proverbs 11:25 “The generous will prosper; those who refresh others will themselves be refreshed.”

Luke 6:38 “Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you.”

2 Corinthians 9:6-7 “Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. Each man should give what he has decided in his heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.”

2. The PROMISE.

Philippians 4:19 “And my God shall supply all your need...”

Genesis 22:14 “Jehovah-Jireh: God will provide”.

Psalms 81:10 “Open your mouth wide, and I will fill it with good things.”
