

We launched as a portable church and held our first service at Nathan Hale High School on September 21st.

2019

We purchased and closed on our first permanent facility located at 7515 W National Avenue on December 23rd.



2020

After COVID gathering restrictions were lifted, we dedicated and began holding services in our new building on June 21st.




2022

As the church rapidly grew, the leadership team made the bold decision to purchase an additional church facility located across the street from our first building. We officially opened the doors to our new facility located on 1642 S. 77th Street on December 4, 2022.



2024

We joyfully celebrated a decade of God's faithfulness with a special birthday celebration service and a message from ARC President, Greg Surratt.



2025

With the congregation once again outgrowing its current facilities, the church leadership team made the decision to submit an offer to purchase a 60,000 s.f. building in New Berlin, WI that would accommodate our growing church family with adequate parking and kids' ministry space.


Our church is standing at a pivotal moment, one that calls for deeper worship, greater surrender, and a willingness to follow God into what He is preparing next.

PRIMARY GOAL
100% PARTICIPATION

God has a unique Table Setter story to author in and through each of us. We simply must say, "Yes!"

The primary goal is intentional because stewardship is ultimately trusting God with what he has already given us. For a fully engaged follower of Jesus, all of life is spiritual, including how we invest our resources to build His kingdom—not from a place of obligation, but with joy, expectation, and faith.

To become Table Setters, this is a journey we must take—a choice to steward what we've been given, to give consistently, and to grow in generosity.

SECONDARY GOAL

\$3.99 MILLION

(Over the next two years)

Through 100% participation, our faith compels us to trust God with our collective investment as Table Setters.

Our secondary goal is a One Fund initiative. That simply means we are trusting God for this amount to cover all of our expenses for the next two years, which provides for our ongoing ministry advancement, increased missions efforts, and expanded facilities.

→ MINISTRY

The Table Setters' story for our ministry is written into this secondary goal. All the initiatives necessary to fund the local expression of the 414 Church are included in the Table Setters one fund vision.

→ MISSIONS

The Table Setters' story for our increased mission efforts is part of our unwavering commitment to answer God's calling to reach the world in Jesus' name. This secondary goal includes all of our missions initiatives such as making room in our community (Local Missions Partners), setting tables in new cities (Church Planting), raising and equipping the current and next generation of leaders (Leadership Development), preparing a place for the next generation (Youth Ministries), extending the table to the nations (World Mission) and serving children and families in need (Compassion Projects).

→ BUILDING

The Table Setters' story of seeing changed lives, changing lives, includes preparing a larger and more fully equipped home. A place where every room is stewarded well and every space is ready for the people God is bringing. By expanding our capacity, we are making more room at the table for lives to be shaped by the truth of Jesus.

ONE FUND INITIATIVE


In the past, we've had campaigns where we asked the church family to invest a second gift "over and above" your regular giving.

However, we've found that "over and above" giving is potentially confusing to people who don't have a baseline for their "normal giving." It also has the potential to diminish the significance of the ongoing generous giving of so many people at 414 Church.

The initial phase of Table Setters will last two years. In those two years, every gift will go to Table Setters to help us say "Yes!" with greater faith and boldness to the plans God has in store for our community, our church, and our lives.

The Table Setters' story has always been bigger than the local expression of 414 Church. As part of this season, we are continuing to commit significant resources beyond our walls because the future God is calling us into has always included our city and the nations. This investment expands our reach through trusted local, national, and global partners who reflect God's heart for people.

Through partners like Children's Cup, One Hope, Watoto, and Compassion International, disadvantaged children around the world are cared for holistically. They receive education, support, and spiritual formation that break cycles of generational poverty.

Through partners like Firm Israel, Project 42, and the missionaries we support, we are bringing the gospel to unreached people groups around the world. In places where few have heard the name of Jesus, these ministries are sharing Christ, discipling believers, and establishing new expressions of the Church among those who have never had access to the hope of the gospel.

Right here at home, the love of Jesus is extended through partners like Milwaukee Rescue Mission, Redeem and Restore, Teen Challenge, and ATK Ministries. This is not short-term relief. This is generational impact.

Through church planting and equipping pastors, we help prepare tables in cities around the nation and the world for people to encounter Jesus. We are honored to serve alongside organizations such as the Association of Related Churches (ARC), Next Level Relational Network, Pastor's Discipleship Network, and Be Still.

As we invest locally and globally, we build with open hands, trusting that lives we may never meet, in places we may never go, will be changed because we chose to prepare the table in this moment.


BUILDING PREPARING A PLACE FOR WHAT GOD IS DOING NEXT

PREPARING A PLACE FOR THE NEXT GENERATION




Kids & Youth Ministry Wing

INITIAL GIVER

Partnership in the gospel.
Philippians 1:5:6

An Initial Giver is someone who decides to give for the first time, out of a response to God's Word about giving. This is someone who decides to give something and trust God and leaders of the church with this gift.

PRAYER TO PRAY:

"God, do I trust you as my Provider? Show me how to demonstrate to You my trust in You by starting somewhere and beginning to give."

O2

CONSISTENT GIVER

Since You have excelled, excel here too.
2 Corinthians 8:7

A Consistent Giver is someone who decides to give something and to give it on a consistent basis to exercise the discipline of giving. Often, someone who decides to make their gift an online/digital recurring gift will be someone who is learning the behavior of consistency. Those who prefer to not give digitally can also be consistent givers. It just requires more discipline.

PRAYER TO PRAY:

"God, am I giving on a consistent basis that shows my desire to excel in this area of discipleship? Show me how to become more consistent and disciplined in my giving."

03

INTENTIONAL GIVER

Making your giving purposeful/planning.
2 Corinthians 9:7

An Intentional Giver is someone who thinks about their giving in relation to their other financial priorities. This giver starts to make their giving an intentional choice that reflects how they prioritize it in relation to other things on which they spend money.

PRAYER TO PRAY:

"In comparison to my other financial priorities, does my giving accurately reflect how I feel about God? Or do some changes need to be made? God, show me what it looks like to give in such a way that shows you are first in my life.

04

SURRENDERED GIVER

Because of all God has done, we surrender our entire selves to Him.

Romans 12:1

A Surrendered Giver is someone who recognizes the power of the gospel and is surrendered to honoring God with 100% of their resources as a result. A Surrendered Giver is someone who gives in a way that changes them, in a way that reflects that their giving is governing their spending/saving rather than their spending/saving governing their giving. A Surrendered Giver isn't just concerned about what they ARE giving, but is more concerned with what they're NOT giving and why. They seek to honor God with all He has given them, whether that means direct monetary giving or a God-honoring use of an existing resource.

PRAYER TO PRAY:

"God, what am I NOT giving and why? Am I truly honoring You with 100% of what You have given me, not just a portion? God, show me what it looks like to honor You with all of my heart, soul, and might."

05

ETERNAL GIVER

Our hope is not in earthly things, but in eternal things.

1 Timothy 6:19

An Eternal Giver is someone who is thinking about the longer tail of generosity rather than just month-to-month or even year-to-year generosity. An Eternal Giver makes decisions in the short term that have long-term effects as it relates to their generosity capacity. They think of what home they'll buy, what car they'll purchase, how much savings they choose to keep, all in relation to their generosity capacity. An Eternal Giver is driven by things of eternity, putting their hope in God and not in the things of this earth.

PRAYER TO PRAY:

"God, do I make large resource decisions in light of eternity or in light of my time here on earth? Lord, help me to see more clearly that You alone are sovereign, that everything ultimately bows to Your authority. Let my actions flow from deep love and devotion to You, not just for the sake of this moment, but with eternity in mind."

THE GIVING JOURNEY

The Giving Journey on the previous pages (28–29) describes who we are becoming as stewards.

This Monthly Giving Percentage Guide is designed to help with the math of that journey.

For many of us, generosity feels abstract until we can see what a faithful step actually looks like in real numbers. This guide translates annual income into simple monthly amounts so you can prayerfully discern what the next step might be.

This tool is to help you connect spiritual intention with tangible action. Whether you are taking a first step or stretching into a new season of generosity, this chart helps you understand how incremental steps can add up to meaningful Kingdom impact over time.

HOW TO GET INVOLVED

Generosity often begins with small, intentional decisions.

Stepping into a Table Setters commitment can include redirecting what is already flowing out.

The ideas below are simply tools to help you identify areas where temporary adjustments could create lasting impact. Not every idea will fit every family. The goal is not to do everything, but to discern one or two faithful changes that align your resources with God's invitation in this season.

STEP ONE: PRAY

Pray that the Lord would help you discern your role and give you the discipline and creativity to find ways to join the Table Setters journey.

STEP TWO: THINK ABOUT LIFESTYLE CHANGES

Adjust some current spending so you can give to Table Setters. Include the whole family in the conversation—it's an important discipleship opportunity.

HOW CAN I GIVE MY ASSETS TO TABLE SETTERS?

Real Estate: Ownership can be transferred as long as there are no liens on the property. Real estate gifts will be initially credited at a value determined through an appraisal obtained by both the donor and the church. When the property has been sold, the church will notify the donor of the sale price. The amount credited to the donor will be adjusted accordingly, and the donor will be informed of the adjustment.

All Other Assets: We request that gifts such as jewelry, vehicles, artwork, or similar items be sold first, with the proceeds donated to Table Setters. As with all cash contributions, these proceeds are 100% tax-deductible.

Marketable Securities: Stocks, bonds, and mutual funds can be given to the Table Setters initiative without incurring capital gains on these assets. For example, if stocks were purchased for \$100 and then appreciated to \$1,000, you would be liable for a capital gain tax for the \$900 of appreciation. If donated, the contributor avoids having to pay capital gains tax and still receives a \$1,000 tax deduction.

WHAT IS INCLUDED IN THE CONSTRUCTION AND RENOVATION?

Phase One will include an 800+ seat auditorium, mother's nursing room, and a large centralized lobby with plenty of gathering space.

Phase Two will create a dedicated space designed specifically for children and students. It will allow us to accommodate 200 children in our Sunday services as well as 200 for our midweek youth service. This dedicated environment will be safe and joyful helping kids and students discover who Jesus is and who they are becoming. Phase Two will also allow us to consider utilizing the space during the week for a top-quality Christian preschool.

Phase Three will create space for church administration, leadership development, adult education, and future ministry internships and schooling.

WHAT WILL BE THE COST?

The total budget of Phase One is projected to be approximately \$1.49 million. Any decrease in costs or surplus in funds raised will accelerate completion of Phases Two and Three of the project.

HOW WILL WE PAY FOR IT?

From February 15, 2026—March 31, 2028, we will engage in a campaign to raise the resources to support this Spirit-led initiative.

WHO WILL BE DOING THE WORK?

Our architectural design firm is CKA—Christopher Kidd & Associates. Our Board of Trustees, along with the staff and overseers, will look first to local contractors, subcontractors, and suppliers to execute the work.

WHEN WILL THE BUILD-OUT PROJECT COMMENCE?

Our target date to commence is April 1, 2026. We plan to begin worshiping in our new auditorium by January of 2027.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN WITH OUR CURRENT FACILITIES?

As of now, both of our West Allis properties are on the market and will be sold.

WHAT HAPPENS IF WE DO NOT RAISE THE MONEY?

While we trust that God will provide \$3.99 million incremental dollars over the next two years, if we are unable to raise the money, we will extend our time horizon or scale down the project. Meaning, we will extend our initiative beyond two years or scale down the size of the project to fit our giving level.

HOW DOES TABLE SETTERS CHANGE MY GIVING TO MISSIONS, THE GENERAL FUND, AND OTHER SPECIAL OFFERINGS?

During this two-year initiative, we are focusing all of our efforts and resources toward accomplishing the God-given vision of Table Setters. Table Setters is a comprehensive initiative that includes ALL of our ministries and missions in one fund. That means that all of our giving to 414 for the next two years will be directed to the Table Setters initiative. Our board and Finance Team will ensure that ministry and mission needs are resourced according to our church's priorities. There is power and greater impact when we are strategic and focused.

WHY SHOULD I COMPLETE AND SUBMIT A TABLE SETTERS COMMITMENT CARD?

We commit to many things, from our marriage to a mortgage, even to a membership at the local gym. We wouldn't get very far in life without a willingness to commit ourselves. Commitment is central to our faith and at the very heart of following Jesus. When we make a commitment to Him, He expects us to be committed to His Body, the Church. Our church needs to know what you are committing to give so we can plan and proceed accordingly. God grows us and shapes us according to our priorities and through the commitments we make to Him. So we invite you to take this powerful, life-changing discipleship step by joining us with your two-year Table Setters generosity commitment.

HOW LONG IS MY COMMITMENT?

Table Setters is a two-year Spirit-led initiative, so our commitments are for two years, beginning on March 15, 2026 through March 31, 2028. This giving season will cover three tax years.

ARE THERE WAYS I CAN GIVE ASSETS TO TABLE SETTERS?

Gifts of appreciated property (stocks, real estate, mutual funds, jewelry, artwork, collectibles, etc.) can bring significant tax advantages. Real estate can be transferred to the church for a tax credit based on appraisal and eventual sale price. Stocks, bonds, and mutual funds can be transferred to the church without incurring capital gains taxes on the assets. You may have many kinds of stored resources that God has blessed you with in the past that He just might be calling you to give during this time. WHAT IF I'M NOT A MEMBER OF 414 CHURCH?

These are exciting days at 414 Church and will no doubt be remembered for years to come. You are here, and we would love for you to go with us on this amazing journey of faith. If you watch and wait, you won't be able to truly share in the joy of this season or experience all God has for you. We believe God brought you here, and we want you to be a part of all God is doing at 414 Church. We need you on the team, and this is a perfect time for you to put a stake in the ground and make 414 your home church.

WHAT IF I HAVE NEVER GIVEN, OR DON'T REGULARLY GIVE TO 414?

This would be a great time to start! The primary goal of Table Setters is 100% engagement of everyone at 414, and that includes you. We are praying this will be a disciple-making, faith-building, life-changing experience in our church and in your own heart and life. To get anywhere, you must start somewhere, and Table Setters is a great place to start your giving adventure.

WHAT IS THE "RIGHT AMOUNT" TO GIVE?

2 Corinthians 9:6–7 says, “Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.” Everyone’s situation is unique, but we are all called to give. Our challenge, no matter what you currently give, is to take a step forward in your generosity journey.

WHAT IF I'M NOT IN A GOOD PLACE OR POSITION TO GIVE TO TABLE SETTERS RIGHT NOW?

The reality is, there will never be a “better time” to begin the faith journey in giving generously to the Lord, than right now. God calls us to action in times of hardship as much as He does in times of abundance. Table Setters is about a heart change. One that is only accomplished by surrendering our lives completely over to God in every area, including the area of giving. Believe God, walk in obedience, and trust Him to provide as you sacrifice and work towards fulfilling your commitment. So that may mean you are being challenged to sell things, pick up odd jobs, or even trust God in faith. You might be asked to make a commitment you don’t yet know how to fulfill.
