Rydges is conveniently located having its own private access to the Brisbane Convention and Exhibition Centre, with views over the Brisbane River, Mount Coot-Tha or the cosmopolitan West End. It houses a sauna, pool and a gym. The modern air-conditioned rooms feature a personal safe, a flat-screen TV with cable channels. The property has a restaurant and bar serving a wide range of food and drinks. 24-hour room service is available. The 24-hour front desk can assist with laundry, car rentals and currency exchange services. Valet parking is available to guests for an additional charge.

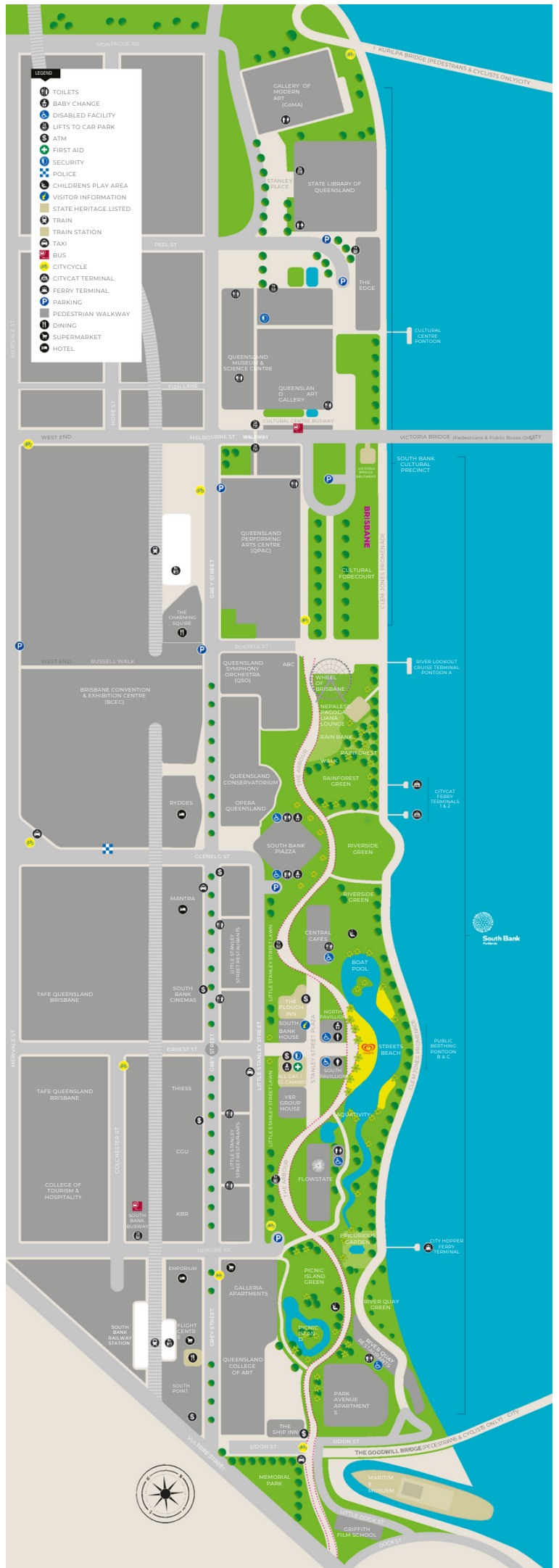

When arriving at Brisbane Domestic or Brisbane International Airport there are many different transportation options for you and/or your family. Southbank Brisbane is a 16km journey from the local Airports so we advise you familiarise yourself with the transport options ahead of time.

Car Hire: You will find all the major car hire companies at Brisbane Airport offering cheap rates including Avis, Budget, Enterprise, Hertz and SIXT. Both the Domestic and International Terminals have convenient locations to pick up your keys and your hire car. *(Please note if you do hire a car during your stay to alert your accommodation of your need for a car-parking space and ask if an additional cost will occur)*

Brisbane Air Train: Brisbane Air Train operates every 20 minutes from 5:50am-10:05pm 7 days a week. Pre-booking your tickets will give you access to a discounted price and ease upon arrival. The train stop you will need to hop off at for the Rydges accommodation is **South Brisbane**. **(Cost is \$16.50/ticket)**

Taxi/Uber: When arriving at both the domestic and international airports you will be greeted by many different taxi company options. Wait in line for the next available taxi for quick and easy transfer to your accommodation. **(Cost can range from \$40-70 for this trip/car)**

Shuttle: Some hotels are able to organise a shuttle service for you to and from the airport. These are usually fulfilled through 3rd party services. If you would like to know more about this option please speak with your accommodation provider.

Need a hand: We understand that travelling to an unfamiliar location with or without additional family members can be tricky. If you require any additional help please let us know.
