MARK 1:21-28

21 They went to Capernaum, and when the Sabbath came, Jesus went into the synagogue and began to teach. 22 The people were amazed at his teaching, because he taught them as one who had authority, not as the teachers of the law.

23 Just then a man in their synagogue who was possessed by an evil spirit cried out, 24 "What do you want with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are--the Holy One of God!" 25 "Be quiet!" said Jesus sternly. "Come out of him!" 26 The evil spirit shook the man violently and came out of him with a shriek.

27 The people were all so amazed that they asked each other, "What is this? A new teaching--and with authority! He even gives orders to evil spirits and they obey him."

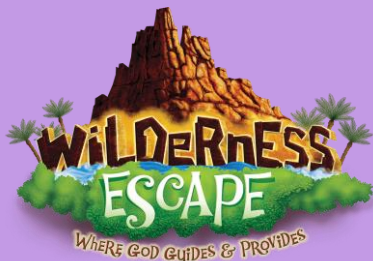
Tent Team

INTRODUCTION

BIG IDEA: Believers should never stop being amazed at what Jesus does.

- I. Jesus' words amaze those who realize he speaks God's Word into their lives.
 1. The synagogue was a place for learning God's Word.
 2. Jesus amazed his listeners by speaking with authority.
- II. Jesus' words are amazing because they have the power to change a life.

Application:

1. Faith is required to be amazed.
2. We may miss being amazed because we are distracted.
3. We need to be listening to God's Word.
4. We need to be in fellowship with other believers.
