SERMON NOTES

Joy Despite Difficulties
I Peter 1:3-9
Introduction

Big Idea: Being confident of God's eternal promises in Christ can give us joy despite difficult circumstances.

- I. We can have joy because of the assurance of eternal life as a child of God.
 - 1. We have a regenerated life in Christ.
 - 2. Assurance come from the knowledge of Christ's resurrection.
 - 3. As God's children we have an inheritance that is secure.
- II. We can have joy knowing that God has good purposes even for our trials.
 - 1. Sustained faith under trial proves it is genuine.
 - 2. The testing of our faith makes it stronger.
 - 3. Sustained faith during trial gives God glory.
- III. Growing more in love with Christ results in joy.
