I Peter 1:22-2:3
Introduction

Big Idea: Because we are both purified and empowered by believing the gospel, we are enabled to please God.

- Obeying the truth is trusting in the gospel, not obeying a command.
 - 1. It requires God's sovereign grace.
 - 2. It involves personal choices.
- II. Obeying the truth should be a daily practice.
 - 1. It is demonstrated in love for fellow believers.
 - 2. It is demonstrated in putting off sinful attitudes and actions.
 - 3. It is demonstrated in a sincere desire to grow in the knowledge of God's word.
