How to Have Good Days

I Peter 3:8-12

Intro.

Big Idea: By following the example of Jesus we can expect to have good days.

- I. Being loving in concrete ways will lead to good days.
Jn. 17:23; Eph.4:4
 1. Seeking unity with Christ-followers. (Harmony)
Jn. 17:23; Eph. 4:4
 2. Feeling what others are feeling. (Sympathy)
Rom. 12:5; Heb. 4:15
 3. Having brotherly affection. (Brotherly Love)
Romans 12:10
 4. By being aware of other's needs. (Compassion)
Ex. 34:6; Rom. 5:8
 5. By putting others ahead of yourself. (Humility)
Phil.2:3-5
- II. Choosing Jesus' example of non-retaliation will lead to good days.
 1. Things to avoid:
Evil speaking, deceitful speech, things that injure.
 2. Actively initiate peace in personal relationships.
