
# Covenant of Grace Worship Service

**SCRIPTURE** \*ISAIAH 9:6-7a; HEBREWS 5:7-9;12:1-2

6 For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. 7 Of the increase of his government and peace there will be no end.

7 During the days of Jesus' life on earth, he offered up prayers and petitions with loud cries and tears to the one who could save him from death, and he was heard because of his reverent submission. 8 Although he was a son, he learned obedience from what he suffered 9 and, once made perfect, he became the source of eternal salvation for all who obey him.

1 Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles, and let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us. 2 Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

Isaiah 9:6-7a; Hebrews 5:7-9; 12:1-2

Introduction

Big Idea: We are to be grateful to Jesus for all aspects of our salvation.

I. Jesus is the Father of Eternity because he is the <u>first</u> to experience complete resurrection.

II. Jesus is the Father of Eternity because he is the <u>source</u> of our new life.
