## **Rhythms of Mission**

**SENDING MISSION** | CrossPointe Coast on both ends of the rope.

It is our desire at CrossPointe Coast to involve both those who go and those who stay in the joyful gain of the missionary's fruitful labor. Therefore, CrossPointe partners will both respond to God's call to go into all the world and preach the Gospel and will support those whom we send with our time, talent and treasure.

**DISCOVERY MISSION** | Discovering genuine, relationally-connected love and engagement with the global church.

One of the greatest things that we can discover from the church around the globe is a genuine, relationally-connected love for the people of God and a desire to join in pointing communities around the globe to Jesus Christ.

We will partner to send short-term groups to churches and mission outposts. We desire to go as learners and partners seeking to connect the two ends of the Sending Mission rope.

### **COMMUNITY MISSION |** Gospel Communities on Mission

The call to Community Mission is a call to realize that we are engaged as missionaries in our own cultural context. We must, therefore, come to know the suffering and idolatry of our community and how to bring the truth of the Gospel to bear with clarity and compassion.

Community Groups are the primary means of engagement in Community Mission. Many of the opportunities for the Gospel in the community are best engaged not through an organized ministry or institution, but through more regular and intentional engagement of households and Community Groups in the lives of our neighbors.

#### **EVERYDAY MISSION |** Daily lives of faith-filled obedience

Gospel proclamation does not begin on the other side of an airplane flight or upon arrival to a soup kitchen. Gospel proclamation begins in the morning when your heart needs to hear the joy of salvation. Mission continues as we make known the Gospel to our households. It then moves into our neighborhoods and networks. It is as we live daily lives of faith-filled obedience for the sake of Christ and His Gospel that we will learn the meaning of Philippians 1:21-22, "For to me to live is Christ, and to die is gain. If I am to live in the flesh, that means fruitful labor for me."

## **Forever Mercy | South Africa**



John and Naomi Menton helped to plant CPCoast and served alongside the Fyffe's and others for several years before God called them to foster care and adoption ministry in South Africa in 2012. They left with 3 girls and are now raising 8 children: Emily, Nooria, Ava, Nuuranah, Nkosi, Tita, Olo; and Chris. They stay very busy homeschooling and driving kids to extracurricular activities such as ballet, soccer, and horseback riding. John also serves at Grace Bible Church were he and Naomi lead worship.

- The children are all transitioning into new grades. The South African school year begins in January.

We've recently added visits from a Christian psychologist every month to better serve our children. The children have been busy catching up on missed school days due to COVID-19 restrictions through tutoring. Beautifully and prayerfully we are walking with one of our children through her potential adoption by a Christian Mongolian family. And finally, the kids are excited to have recently celebrated the birth of a new cow on our property! In spite of life's many challenges, new life continues to spring up at New Hope!

- Please pray for little Ariuka's adoption. Pray for wisdom and clarity for our leaders, the potential new family, the Department of Child Services, and for Ariuka, who gets to be a part of the decision.
- Please pray for Jesus to continually transform the lives of our beloved Mongolian staff. And in response, may they boldly and lovingly proclaim His good news to our children, despite government opposition.
- Please pray for our home build. Pray for our land certificate to be approved, material costs to decrease, and for the needed funds to be raised. Pray for wisdom as we discern the timeline and for us to secure a new builder for this crucial project.

## **InterVarsity | Central & South Florida**



Tim Gonyer serves as a regional director for InterVarsity. Having recently completed 11 years on staff and 2 years of volunteer work, Tim is currently on Sabbatical. In his most recent newsletter he expressed extreme gratitude to InterVarsity for providing him this opportunity. Between the disruption of the pandemic and the expansion of Tim's area to include south Florida, he feels it is an invitation from Jesus to step into deeper faith in him. Tim believes the next season of work with InterVarsity will continue to stretch him in new ways that will both be exciting and challenging.

Bill and his family were part of the team that planted CrossPointe Coast and it was at CrossPointe that the initial vision for GracePointe Church was birthed. Bill wanted to plant a church that was deeply focused on the gospel being central in everything in the church and in multiplication through the planting of healthy churches.

In 2012, Bill sensed the call to take this vision to Williamsburg, VA to plant a gospel-centered church for God's glory. Later that year, CrossPointe sent the Dumphy family to Williamsburg to plant what would ultimately become GracePointe Church.

- GracePointe will have a baptism on March 6.
- Praise for organic growth. GracePointe has six expecting mothers.
- Children's ministry is growing. GracePointe recently added a 5th children's class.

## CrossPointe Español | Orlando, FL



Miguel Medina, pastor of CrossPointe Español was born and raised in Puerto Rico and moved to Orlando with his family when he was 19 years old. In 2014, Miguel began a Church Planting Apprenticeship with CrossPointe Orlando and in 2015 he and his wife, Carmen launched CrossPointe Español, a Spanish-speaking congregation.

CPCoast has had the privilege of partnering closely with CPEspañol since 2018. In addition to financially supporting them as a young church plant, CPCoast serves alongside CPEspañol in elder partnership and administrative support.

- In addition to pastoring CPEspañol, Miguel is assisting Acts 29 in building a more robust ministry to Spanish-speaking communities and countries. Pray for wisdom and strength as he balances his responsibilities.
- Provision for and of a part-time worship leader/pastoral assistant.
- Miguel is currently working with a few men for elder development and training. Pray for these men, that God would prepare their hearts for ministry.

## **CrossPointe | Jupiter, FL**
