I did not know Julianne personally but from everyone I have spoken with, she was an incredible young lady with a bright future. My heart has groaned this week thinking about her family, her friends and those involved in the wreck. I have also heard the cry of students struggling to process such a tragic moment. Others have asked numerous questions like, Why did God allow this? Does He even care? I think that's the cry of the soul. We look around us and think, "This isn't right." Something within cries, "It isn't supposed to be this way!"

Those questions do not reveal a lack of faith, they instead reveal a truth about all of us. We were not made to experience such pain. Death was not to be our norm. Therefore, it prompts struggle and pain as we wrestle with its presence. Yet, as we suffer the pain of death on this earth, we are reminded that God has suffered as well for it.
