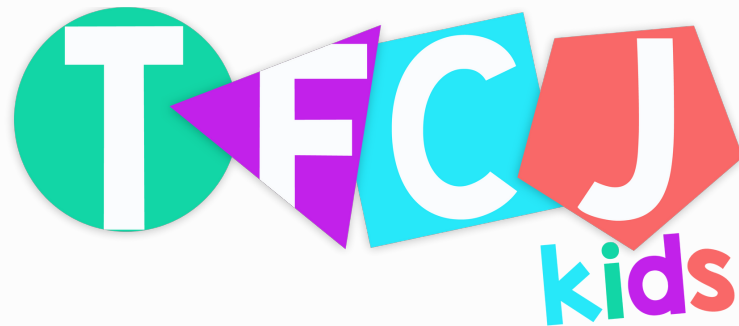

Top 4 things to Know

- 1. Your child's health and safety is important to us.** We will be checking temperatures and wearing masks during children's church. If your child is showing any signs of illness please keep them home, they are welcome to join in our lesson virtually. We make sure to keep our kids' area safe by only allowing our team members and parents access to the children's area.
- 2. Check-in and Check Out Procedures.** Check in for children's church will happen at the welcome center. When your child is checked in, a label will print for you and your child. You will need your portion to pick up your child after service.
- 3. We feed our children.** We serve a breakfast meal and/or snack every service. It is important to share any dietary restrictions with us to make sure that we are maintaining appropriate dietary restrictions.
- 4. It's not babysitting, it's discipleship making.** We teach our kids about Jesus on their level. We have prayer, worship, lessons and activities every service. We make sure that you are aware of what we are teaching so it can be reviewed and reenforced at home.
