



Jamaica Compassion Trip

Partnership:

Hope Students is partnering with SonServants (sonservants.org), who has been serving through local organizations in Jamaica since 1989. This trip is built specifically with our Seniors in mind. We will care for the community of Mandeville through possible construction projects in local schools, helping residents build houses, and sitting with what Scripture may call "the least of these." We also want to give students specific space to reflect on what the Lord has done during their time in Hope Students and prepare them as they head into what the Lord has next for them. Our prayer is that our students' love and compassion are expanded for the people that God loves. We also pray that this is a time of closeness with the Lord as he is calling us to serve and abide in him.

Accommodations

We will be accompanied by a Son Servants staff and the Director, Danny Dotson, will be joining us. We will be staying at Moorlands Camp, in gender specific housing.

Meals

We will cover all meals for this trip. Breakfast is served at camp. Lunch will be packed every morning and we will eat at the worksite. We ask that if you have any dietary restrictions, that you bring what you need to eat instead of what will be provided for lunch. Dinner will be served at camp every night by kitchen staff at Moorlands Camp. We do not supply our group with water bottles. Please be sure that each participant brings a reusable water bottle with them that they can fill up each morning.

Dress Code

Bring clothes that are comfortable to work in and you do not mind getting dirty. Closed Toed Shoes are a REQUIREMENT. Shorts need to be past fingertip length. No tank tops or sleeveless shirts. Long sleeved shirt is recommended.

Around the area

Due to the nature of our accommodations being at a secure camp, we will spend most of our time here if not on the worksite. We will travel together to the worksites accompanied by SonServants staff. We will not be exploring the surrounding area at all during our work days. Our plan is to have a fun day at YS Falls, a tourist attraction with waterfalls and natural swimming pools. We will be traveling as a whole group everywhere we go.
