Partnership:

Hope Students is partnering with YoungLife International in Greenock, Scotland. We will be the Work Crew and encouragement for the Scottish team for their yearly *Stage 'N Slam* Day Camp. This camp serves the middle and high school students of Greenock, a town that has been dubbed “the most deprived area in Scotland” based on income and health. Through our presence, prayer, and hard work, we will show the students of Greenock that their worth and identity is found in Christ.

Price: \$2600 *dependent on flights

We will encourage students that the funds are raised through donations and partnerships with family, friends, and neighbors etc. We will walk through this process with them upon acceptance to the trip.

This trip requires an application and an interview for acceptance to the team.

Accommodations

Students will be housed with host homes connected to the home church: Greenock Baptist (groups of 3-5 at each house). These families have been vetted through YoungLife International. This becomes one of the most cherished details about this trip– the connection made with a local family.

Meals

Breakfast is served at each particular housing site (cereal, toast, fruit, etc.) with the family.

Lunch & dinner will be provided by local churches and we will eat as a full group.

Water Bottles are necessary for the trip.

Dress Code

Bring clothes that are comfortable to work in and you do not mind getting dirty. It can get chilly and windy in Greenock, so you will need to pack accordingly. Pants and closed toed shoes are required. Teva/Chacos types sandals are okay as well. No tank tops or sleeveless shirts. Leggings are not pants. Long sleeved shirt and sweatshirt is recommended. Must have a raincoat.

At the housing site

Please be respectful of the house we use and the family in it. We need to be respectful of the space, the curfew, and aware of noise levels. Please keep your space neat and clean. Quiet hours will be given before you leave the work site each day. Your host home will either bring you in the morning or you will walk to the work site.

Around the area

Bring only what you want to carry with you. Always stick with your group and listen to the instructions of your leaders and YL staff. Never wander off on your own– stay in pairs or in groups with a leader at all times and stay aware of your surroundings. Keep any money on you minimal. We advise a credit card to make international purchases. Do not give out your home address, phone number, instagram accounts, etc. We will build a team Instagram account that you can have access to. Pay attention as you walk down the sidewalk.

General Rules & Guidelines

Drugs, alcohol and tobacco are not permitted. No PDA. Too much friendly attention to the opposite sex may lead to miscommunication. Ask permission before taking any photographs. Some children are not legally able to have their picture taken and some people simply would not prefer to have their photo taken.
