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CONNECT

What traditions do you hold around Easter? If none, what might be a tradition you'd like to begin this year?

FOLLOW-UP FROM LAST WEEK

Jesus's death on the cross was the final work of salvation for all mankind. There is nothing you can do to make this more true than it already is. Where did you feel the tension between knowing that and actually living like it's true this week?

ENGAGE

Read Exodus 12: 1-14 together.

Drew retold this story from the perspective of someone living through it.

- What images, emotions, or moments from the story stayed with you?
- What feels confusing, unsettling, or hard to understand?
- Where do you begin to see connections to Jesus?

APPLY

(Try to resist jumping too quickly to "the answer." Sit in the story first.)

- The Israelites were saved through something very specific and very strange—*the blood of a lamb over a doorway*. What do you do with that? What does it reveal about God... or challenge in you?
- They didn't fully understand what God was doing—they simply obeyed. Where do you see that same dynamic in your own faith (or resistance to it)?
- They walked out of slavery by passing through a doorway marked by blood. What might it look like to actually "walk out" of something in your life? What makes that difficult?

PRAYER

Father, Your Word is deep and sometimes even difficult for us to understand. Thank you that, through the details of these stories and ancient traditions, You invite us to trust You. Thank you for making a way through Jesus— even when we're still learning what that means. Help us to remember, to trust, and to walk in the freedom You've given us. Amen.

GOING DEEPER

God tells His people to remember and rehearse this story every year.

Why do you think He builds remembrance into their lives like that?

What happens—to individuals or communities—when stories of deliverance are forgotten? What steps can you take to remember and rehearse your own story of deliverance through Jesus?
