**INTRODUCTION:**

**READING: 1 Corinthians 11:23-26 [NIV]**

23 For I received from the Lord what I also passed on to you: The Lord Jesus, on the night he was betrayed, took bread, 24 and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, "This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me." 25 In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me." 26 For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.

**TABLE STUDY:**

1. According to Paul in verse 23 when did the Last Supper take place? Why is this significant?
2. What is the significance of the bread? What is the significance of the wine?
3. Do you remember what feast they were celebrating? (Look at Mark 14:12 for a hint)
4. What is the purpose of communion according to verse 26?

## **TEACHING NOTES:**

## **TABLE DISCUSSION:**

1. How can we follow Mary's example of making Jesus a priority by taking time to be with Him and to honor Him? What prevents you from worshiping Jesus with the kind of passion that Mary showed?
2. What does your prayer life look like?
3. On the cross Jesus fulfilled the old covenant and established a new covenant. Communion is something we are commanded to do "in remembrance of me" (Jesus). How does participating in communion impact you?
