- Read the passage from Sunday together (Genesis 1:1-27)

- Offer a time to discuss the sermon together.
 - Discuss the order and beauty of the first days of Creation. Discuss God's delight in creating.

 - Spend time relishing in what God has created for you to enjoy. Share and talk about the beauty of this world.

 - How important is it that scripture starts with God being the one and only creator?

- Chapters 6 and 7
 - Read the quotes from John Bunyan out loud on page 62. Does any part of this resonate with you? Do we still struggle to remember Jesus' goodness in His promising to never cast us out?

- On page 63, our author writes about how sinners find it difficult to succumb to this grace. "Fallen, anxious sinners are limitless..." Why is it so hard for us to fall into the grace of the gospel?

- Do you have any fears (either now or as a new believer) that the blood of Jesus would run out? That you would one day not be able to call upon His gospel gift anymore?

- What does it mean to feel the weight of your sin? When do you feel the weight of your sin the most?
- Do you trust God to fully forgive your sin? Why does He do this for us?
- Read the paragraph at the top of pg. 71. “The greater the misery is...”. Discuss this idea that Jesus is ALWAYS for us. That He looks on our person. What comfort do you feel in this?
