### **Deacons Fund Taking October Offering for Afghan Refugees**

If you have kept up with the refugee crisis in Afghanistan then you know how heartbreaking it is. Thousands of families have been forced to flee the home that they love and many will be resettled in the U.S. **Good news: you can help.** World Relief of the Triad has been asked by the government to help in the resettling of five Afghan refugee families in our area. The cost per family is \$10,000. Redeemer has committed to sponsoring (at least) one family.

During the entire month of October, we ask you to give to World Relief Refugee Resettlement through the Deacons Fund. It has been the practice of earmarking certain specific Deacons Fund monies for a particular time sensitive relief effort. Any money that comes in to the Deacon's Fund in October will go directly to World Relief.
