- Read the passage from Sunday together (Genesis 3:8-24)

- Offer a time to discuss the sermon together.
 - What is sin?

 - What is the difference between guilt and shame?

 - Why is shame our first response to sin?

 - Walk through the end of this passage where God meets Adam and Eve in the garden. Look at our God's actions of giving judgement (not a curse) and offering a chance of repentance to Adam and Eve. God then gives the "leather instead of fig leaves". What do you see in the heart of God here?

- Chapters 20 and 21
 - Discuss the ideas of living life *for* the heart and *from* the heart of Christ. What does the author mean by this idea? Do you tend to live more one way vs. the other?

 - Do you struggle with acting for God's love and attention? Where do we also see this in Scripture? Why do we do this?

 - Share ways that we can help each other combat lawish hearts to seek out Gods lavish heart.

 - Read Romans 5:6-11.

 - God didn't meet us halfway. We did not have to do X, Y, and Z perfectly to be able to receive his gifts. WHILE we were weak, He sought us. What security can you find in this?

 - Close by reading through the Spurgeon quote on page 195.
