

1. READ all of chapter 14. We are here. The Passion Narrative has begun. Sit with the chapter for a moment. What stands out to you as you read? After going through all of Mark up to this point, is anything shocking or surprising to you?
2. Mark 14:1-11. This scene is sandwiched between the religious leaders plotting to kill Jesus and Judas betraying Him. Mark tells us about the woman who anoints Jesus with perfume. What does Jesus say she is doing?
3. Mark 14:12-31. What parts of the institution of the Lord's Supper stand out to you here? Do the disciples understand what is going on? What does Peter promise the Lord? What does Jesus say?

4. Mark 14:32-72. We see the disciples sleeping when Jesus had asked them to stay awake with Him, and then Peter denying Jesus three times. Do you see your own walk with the Lord in their actions? In what ways do we also fall asleep or deny Him?
5. PRAY. Take a moment to think about what you've read today. Write a prayer asking the Lord to apply these words to your heart; ask Him to have these words affect the way you pray and seek after Him; ask to see Him. In your prayer write down any sins that are weighing you down or holding you back, repent of them and ask for freedom. End your prayer with thanksgiving and praise that He sent His son for YOUR and has forgiven you.
