BIG POINT: I AM NOT ALONE

Bible Reading

Matthew 28:20 (NirV), "Teach them to obey everything I have commanded you. And you can be sure that I am always with you, to the very end."

Family Devotional

We've all had times when we feel overwhelmed and alone. We could be surrounded by people and still feel alone. The good news is this, we are not alone. God meets us right where we are. There's nowhere we can go that God can't reach us. We don't need to be afraid.

God spoke to Joshua saying, Joshua 1:9 (NirV), "Here is what I am commanding you to do. Be strong and brave. Do not be afraid. Do not lose hope. I am the Lord your God. I will be with you everywhere you go." No matter where we go God is with us.

The same promise is ours today. When Jesus ascended to Heaven he promised to send a helper who would be with us always, the Holy Spirit. No matter what challenge we face, or how alone we may feel the Holy Spirit is right there to help us.

You might find yourself feeling alone sometimes, it's in those times we can remind ourselves that God is with us. Say together, "I am not alone".

Activity: Photo Frame

Supplies needed:

- Photo of you and a friend or family member
- Coloured card paper
- Coloured crayons, pencils or markers
- Stickers
- Glue stick



Step 1: Choose a photo of you and a friend or family member.

Step 2: Lay the photo in the middle of the card paper and trace around the edge of the photo.

Step 3: Next, draw pictures and add stickers to decorate in the border around where the photo will go.

Step 4: Use a little glue to stick the photo in the middle of the frame.

Step 5: Display the photo and frame in your home or give it to a friend of family member to remind them that we are not alone.
