PURPOSE

One of Arrow Heights mission projects for 2024 will be to Wellington, Colorado. This mission project will seek to provide Arrow Heights students & adults with opportunities to meet the social, emotional, and most important, spiritual needs of others through practical experiences focused on servanthood, relationships, Gospel sharing, and personal commitment to missions.

Students and adults at Arrow Heights will be serving in COMMUNITY MISSIONS through the North American Mission Board and StoneBridge Church. Participants will be *on mission* by becoming personally involved in meeting the needs of a church and its community.

THE WORK

In 2021 Arrow Heights began a long-term partnership with North American Mission Board (NAMB) missionaries, **Jon & Tiffany Willhite**, who are from Chouteau, OK. Both Jon & Tiffany sensed a call from God to be NAMB missionaries and plant a church outside the Bible Belt. They were assigned to Northern Colorado and settled in the town of Wellington which is just north of Fort Collins and 30 miles South of Cheyenne, Wyoming. Wellington is the 4th fastest growing community in Colorado. The Willhite's moved their family to Wellington in January 2019. Jon & Tiffany have four children, Cooper -18, Hutson -16, Sawyer -8 and Mia -7.

Spend a week in "Colorado's Northern Gateway" serving, sharing, and bringing hope to the community of Wellington, Colorado. AHBC Team will be joining NAMB missionaries, Jon & Tiffany Willhite and their new NAMB church plant, StoneBridge Church, serving their community with activities including: children's recreation day camp ministry, community service projects, prayer walking. We will also have an opportunity to take in some of the beauty of the Rocky Mountains.

REQUIREMENTS

- All participating students & adults must attend Arrow Heights.
- Students must have completed at least 7th grade by the end of the 23-24 school year BUT a younger child can attend if the child is accompanied by a parent.
- Adults, 18 & older, must complete an online *Ministry to Minors Background Check* AND the 1 hr online course *Ministry Safe* to participate before the first prep meeting.
- Each participant must understand and commit to the project's registration & payment schedule, objectives and prep meetings.
- Participants must be willing and comfortable sharing their testimonies with the Gospel message. Training will be provided.
- Most importantly, be flexible & have a Christ-like servants heart & attitude.

When time allows, our team will do some Colorado sightseeing. Experience some of the beauty of the Rocky Mountains, Estes Park, Downtown Fort Collins, Rocky Mountain National Park.

WHERE: Our mission team will spend a week in Wellington, Colorado.

WHEN: June 15 – 22, 2024

WHO: Open to all Arrow Heights students & adults.

HOW: Transportation to/from Broken Arrow–Wellington, CO; rental vans.

COST: \$250 per person ride in van.

COST: \$160 per person drive/ride in their own/parents vehicle.

Cost includes:

- 7 nights Lodging at Hampton Inn Ft Collins.
- Transportation: Broken Arrow–Wellington round trip van rentals.
- 11 meals while in Wellington/Fort Collins area.
- 2 StoneBridge Church T-shirts.

Cost does NOT include:

- 6 meals & snacks/drinks while traveling to and from Tulsa–Colorado (approx \$60)
- 7 meals will be own your own as our team serves in Wellington and also sightseeing in Colorado. Team eats together. (approx. \$100)
