ADULT DISCUSSION GROUP - November 2 - Psychedelics

Marilyn Anderson will discuss controversial research from a 2025 study by Johns Hopkins and NYU's schools of medicine in which 29 clergy members of Buddhist, Christian, Jewish, and Islamic religions ingested psilocybin (psychedelic mushrooms). Most participants described the experiences as among the most spiritually significant and psychologically meaningful of their lives.
