Acts 5:12-42 "Paradox"

Par.a.dox is a statement or proposition that seems self-contradictory or absurd but in reality expresses a possible truth. Thesis: The normal Christian life reaches & repels receives blessings & beatings while treasuring Jesus above all things displaying His infinite worth & value.

HOW DO WE GET TO VV41-42? Things We Need To Know & Remember . . .

- 1) Disappointment w/ God comes from <u>unrealistic</u> <u>expectations</u> of God. (John 16:33; Rom. 8:36-37; James 1:2; 1 Pet. 4:12-13)
- **2) Life is not a playground but a <u>battleground</u>.** (Eph. 2:1-3; John 10:10; Eph. 6:12; 2Cor. 4:4, 11:3; 1Pet. 5:8)
- 3) God's <u>power</u> shows up according to God's <u>providence</u>. (Acts 5:15 & 40; Heb. 11:32-38; Acts 28:1-10: 2 Cor. 12:8-9)
- **4)** Lots of things <u>don't make sense</u> yet. (Acts 12:1-3; Deut. 29:29; Pro. 3:5-6; 1 Cor. 13:12)
- 5) We always get the grace we need when we need it. (Acts 5:41; 1 Corinthians 10:13; 2 Cor. 1:3, 9:8; 2 Pet. 3:18)
- 6) Treasuring Jesus <u>above all things</u> displays His worth and value. (vv31, 41-42, Heb. 12:2; Phil. 1:21, 3:10, 4:13)

- 1) What is paradoxical about the following statement? The normal Christian life reaches & repels receives blessings & beatings while praising the glory of God's grace. What are some other paradoxical Christian truths? (i.e. Mark 8:35; Matt. 5:3-4, 20:26)
- 2) Read Acts 5:12-42. What stands out to you from this text? The epitome of Christian wholeness & mental health is found in vv41-42. Explain. When you consider the events that precedes vv41-42 how do you explain their rejoicing and uninhibited gospel proclamation?
- 3) Work through the list of things we need to know & remember if we are to get to vv41-42. Which one(s) are strengths and which one(s) growth areas for you? Why are realistic expectations about God important? How do these verses help? (John 16:33; Rom. 8:36-37; James 1:2; 1 Pet. 4:12-13)
- **4)** Do most American Christians & non-Christians see life as a playground or battleground? What difference would it make? (Eph. 2:1-3; John 10:10; Eph. 6:12; 2 Cor. 4:4, 11:3; 1 Pet. 5:8)? Peter goes from his shadow healing people (v15) to being flogged (v40). How is this God's providence (Heb.11:32-38)?
- **5)** Why is it that a lot of things don't make sense- yet (1 Cor. 13:12)? What does it mean that we always get God's grace when we need it (1Cor. 10:13; 2 Cor. 1:3, 9:8)? Pray that DB is a church that treasures Christ above all things displaying his value and worth!
