Part 6: Work – Cultivating the Garden
We worship our work, work at our play & play at our
worship until we encounter Christ & all of life becomes
worship including work & play. In other words God wants
us to live life to its fullest in every area of life and that
includes work. The meta-narrative of the whole Bible:
Creation, Fall, Redemption, & Restoration.

Colossians 3:23-24

- 1) Every part of our lives is to be lived for the Glory of God. V23a "Whatever you do..." 1Cor10:31; Phil4:4
- 2) Work is a <u>blessing</u> not a curse though sin often can make it difficult. V23b "work heartily (breath, life, vitality, energy)..." Gen2:15, 3:17
- 3) You cannot have a meaningful life without work, but don't make your work the meaning of your life (idolatry). V23c "as for the Lord and not for men..." Gen2:2
- 4) All work is <u>dignified</u> by God and a <u>calling</u> from God. V24a "knowing that from the Lord you will receive the inheritance as your reward..." Gen2:2, 7, 14; Mark 6:3; 2Thess3:10
- 5) My work is a <u>witness</u> to the world and <u>worship</u> to God. V24b "You are serving the Lord Christ." Eph6:5-9; Matt5:16; 1Thess4:11-12
 - "A Christian is a walking sermon. They preach far more than a minister does, for they preach all week long." ~ J.C. Ryle
- 6) Three keys to fruitful and fulfilling work: <u>Look in</u> to your gifting. Eph2:10 <u>Look out</u> to what people need. Titus 3:14 <u>Look up</u> to the one who has called you. Col3:23-24

- 7) The quality of our work is inescapably connected to the <u>quality</u> of our <u>rest</u>. Gen2:1-3; Ex20:8-11
- 8) It takes the <u>deep rest</u> of Christ's finished work for your salvation to avoid over-work. Heb4:1-10; Matt.11:28-30; Luke 10:38-42

- 2) Read Colossians 3:23-24. Paraphrase these two verses and apply specific to your work? Living for God's Glory in every part of our lives & your deepest & most durable satisfaction are one in the same pursuit & not dependent on People, Things & Circumstances (1Cor10:31; Phil4:4). Explain
- **3)** How is work a blessing and not a curse though sin often can make it difficult (Gen2:15, 3:17)? You cannot have a meaningful life without work, but don't make your work the meaning of your life (idolatry). Explain.
- 4) How does knowing that all work is dignified by God & a calling from God & that menial & manual work should not be despised or demeaned (Mark 6:3; 2Thess3:10)? How is our work a witness to the world and worship to God (Eph6:5-9; Matt5:16; 1Thess4:11-12)? What are the keys to fruitful & fulfilling work?
- **5)** Why is the quality of our work inescapably connected to the quality of our rest (Gen2:1-3; Ex20:8-11)? How does the deep rest of Christ's finished work for our salvation help us to avoid over-work (Heb4:1-10; Matt.11:28-30; Luke 10:38-42)? What is God speaking to you from this study? Pray that db would be known to be a light in this dark work world (Matt.5:16).
