Sermon Notes

"Marriage 101" 1Peter 3:1-7

Singleness and Marriage are both Gift's From God (1Cor.7:27-31). Human romance is a glorious experience but even the best is a gift from God and a pointer to the ultimate experience of knowing God's love (Ps63:3; John 4:13-14). If you don't develop a deeply fulfilling relationship with Jesus Christ you will either be poorly married or poorly single (2Pet1:3).

MARRIAGE: (Foundational Biblical Truths about Marriage)

- Marriage is <u>God's Idea</u>: It is a lifelong, monogamous relationship between a man and a women. (Genesis2:24-25; Matt19:1-6; Mark7:20-23)
- Men & women are <u>equal</u> in importance but <u>different</u> in performance complimenting one another for an enduring whole life union. (Gen1:26, 2:18-25; Gal3:28)
- Marriage is to be a <u>reenactment</u> of the Gospel of Jesus Christ that <u>refines</u> our character and <u>creates a stable</u> community for the birth and nurture of Children. (Eph5:25-26, 32, 6:1-4; Gen1:27-28)

HUSBANDS: Lead w/ Love (Eph5:25; Mark 10:42-45; John13:12-16)

- Study her comprehensively v7a "live...in an understanding way"
- Honor her with chivalry v7b "showing honor...as the weaker vessel"
- Serve her compellingly v7c "they are heirs with you of the grace of life"

WIVES: Follow w/ Respect (Eph5:22-23)

- Let your <u>actions</u> speak to Him louder than your words of the gospel. Vv1-2 "be subject...that they may be won without a word..."
- Let your <u>inner beauty</u> attract Him more than your outer beauty.
 Vv3-4 "but the hidden person of the heart" (Pro11:22, 31:10-31; 1Tim4:8)
- Let your <u>admiration</u> of Him make Him want to be a more godly man. Vv5-6 "Sarah obeyed...calling Him lord..."

V7 "...so that your prayers may not be hindered." This is an elliptical expression (R.C. Sproul): If husbands fail to submit to their role & responsibility to lead their wives with love, their prayers will be hindered and the same is true for wives if they fail to follow with respect.

How is marriage a reenactment of the Gospel of Jesus Christ that refines character and creates a stable place for children to be nurtured (Eph5:25-26, 32; Gen1:27-28; Eph6:1-4)?
- **3)** What does it mean that husbands are to lead with love (Eph5:25; Mark 10:42-45; John13:12-16)? Take a few minutes and review the three statements from the sermon notes under how a husband leads his wife with love. Give an illustration of what each of those might look like in a marriage relationship.
- 4) A wives submission to her husband is never blind or absolute but always respectful (Eph5:22-23). Explain. Take a few minutes and review the three statements from the sermon notes under how a wife is to follow with respect. Give an illustration of what each of those might look like in a marriage relationship. In v7 "...so that your prayers may not be hindered" is an elliptical expression that applies to both husband & wife. What does it mean? How is Jesus' sacrificial love for us both the pattern & power for us to sacrificially love our spouse? Pray for the marriages at db!
