4 Resolutions

You can't control what will happen to you in 2015 but you can control how you respond, which reveals your character. Your circumstances matter far less to your happiness than you think, it's more about character. Your character is the sum total of your choices. We make our choices and then our choices make us (Josh24:15).

TO RESOLVE: to decide, settle, determine, purpose RESOLUTION: a firm determination to do something

Most resolutions are shallow based on fear and/or pride and don't last. Resolutions that last are much deeper based on a heart captivated by God.

Hebrews 11:23-27

I RESOLVE...

- 1) To be defined <u>by God</u> and not by people. V24 By faith Moses, when he was grown up, <u>refused to be called</u> the son of Pharaoh's daughter.
 - God <u>did not</u> make you to be what someone else wants you to be. Rom12:2
 - It's more about what you <u>want</u> (to be accepted & liked) than what people say, do or think. Pro29:25
 - When you <u>hang out</u> in the throne room of a Holy God you aren't as easily dominated by the opinions of mere humans who are just like you. Rom1:7, 19:23, 14:26-27
- 2) To enjoy the <u>promises of God</u> more than the promises of sin. V25 choosing rather to be <u>mistreated with the people of God</u> than to enjoy the <u>fleeting pleasures of sin</u>.
 - Sin has power over us through its <u>promise</u> of pleasure.
 - The power of sin's promise is <u>broken</u> by the power of God's promise. Titus2:11-12
 - A life of pain with God is infinitely & eternally more satisfying than a life of pleasure without Him. Ps73:3, 13, 17, 25-26; 84:10

- 3) To be shaped by the <u>values</u> of God's <u>Word</u> rather than the values of this world. V26 He considered <u>the reproach of Christ greater wealth</u> than <u>the treasures of Egypt</u>, for he was looking to the reward.
 - The values of this world: To <u>look good</u> (v24 son of Pharaoh's daughter), <u>feel good</u> (v25 pleasures of sin) & <u>have all the goods</u> (v26 treasures of Egypt). 1Jn2:15-17; Matt4:1-11
 - The values of God's Word: God's <u>purpose</u> is more valuable than popularity (Phil1:21, 3:8). <u>People</u> are more valuable than pleasure (Acts20:35; 2Cor8:1-4). <u>Peace of mind</u> is more valuable than possessions (Pro15:17, 17:1).
- **4) To live by <u>faith</u> and not by <u>fear</u>.** V27 <u>By faith</u> he left Egypt, <u>not being</u> <u>afraid</u> of the anger of the king, for he endured as seeing him who is invisible.
 - Faith is truth about God entering your <u>head</u> (Notitia/content), igniting your <u>heart</u> (Assensus/Conviction) & outworking through your <u>hands</u> (Fiducia/Commitment). Heb11:1, 6
 - It's not the size but the <u>object</u> of your faith that matters most.
 The more you get to <u>know</u> the object of your faith the more it will soar. Matt17:20: Rom10:17: Ps9:9-10
 - The closer you get to God through <u>spiritual disciplines</u> the less fear you'll have. 1Tim4:7-8; 2Tim3:16-17; 1Jn4:18-19
