"The Gospel frees us from the need for people's approval and adoration so that we can confront and anger the people we love if that is what is best for them. And although it does not always work, this is the only kind of communication that really changes people. If you love a person so selfishly that you cannot risk their anger, you won't ever tell them the truth they need to hear. If, on the other hand, you tell a person the truth they need, but with harshness and not with the agony of a lover, they won't listen to it. But if you speak the truth with lots of love evident at the same time, there is a great chance that what you say will penetrate the heart and heal. A Gospel-based ministry (or person) is marked by loving honesty, not spin, image and flattery." —Timothy Keller

Growing Notes

- 1) What is the difference between Religion and the Gospel? Do you think that most people who reject the Gospel are rejecting a biblical understanding of the Gospel? Why is it important to know the difference between Religion and the Gospel (Matt7:21-23)?

- **4)** Review the five points and verses under what a Gospel centered people/ministry looks like along with Keller's quote. What stand out to you?
