Sermon Notes

Non-Christians will tend hear gospel presentations as appeals to become a "nice person" rather than a "new person" unless we are clear in articulating the drastic difference between moralism and the Gospel. Even among Christians the default mode of our hearts is "moralism"—that is, the idea that our performance determines how God feels about us. Unless we are actively preaching the gospel to ourselves and others daily, beating it into our hearts continually.... we will easily fall back into "moralism."

Growing Notes

3) Slowly review and reflect on the comparison chart between Religion (Hagar) vs. the Gospel (Sarah). Which one(s) are the most comforting to you? Which one(s) are the most convicting to you? What are some things you can begin to do to beat the gospel into your head and heart more continually? Pray that the Gospel will continue to overtake our lives at db for God's glory and our joy!
