# "Receiving Christ" Luke 3:1-20

Satan who is known as "the Deceiver (Rev12:9)" loves to keep true believers unsure of their salvation making them ineffective and those on their way to hell deluded into thinking they are on their way to heaven.

Salvation is a position where you REPENT and BELIEVE in a moment and maintain for the rest of your life (John 1:12; Mark 1:15).

### Luke 3:1-20

The Gospel is that I'm more sinful than I ever dared to believe (down) & I'm more loved than I ever dared to dream (up). Jn1:29

<u>REPENT</u> (I'm more sinful than I ever dared to believe) Humble Change the <u>root</u> and you'll change the <u>fruit</u>.

#### Root: Changing what you trust in. vv7-9

- If the serpent can't get us to doubt God's existence, he'll get us to doubt His goodness. V7 "You brood of vipers..." (Gen3:1-5)
- We mistrust God either by being very good or by being very bad. Vv7-8 (Luke 15:11-31)
- We break commandments 2-10 to the degree we break commandment one. (Exodus20:3-17)

#### Fruit: Changing your behavior. Vv4-5, 8, 10-14

- If He is truly the King of your life <u>you adapt to Him</u> not Him to you. Vv4-5, 11 Selfishness into Generosity, 12-13 Dishonesty into Integrity, 14 Bullying into Gentleness
- We trust Him 1<sup>st</sup> (root) and obey Him 2<sup>nd</sup> (fruit) not the other way around. We don't obey Him to be saved, we are saved therefore we obey. Eph2:8-10
- Whenever you say, "I'll obey you if..." You're not obeying God, but <u>using</u> Him and trying to make <u>a deal</u> with Him. The "if" is your real god that you are serving.

<u>BELIEVE</u> (I'm more loved than I ever dared to dream) Confidence <u>Enjoy: His Goodness.</u> Vv15-16

 Jesus becomes more <u>beautiful</u> to your imagination & more <u>attractive</u> to your heart than anything else. John 4:14; 6:35; 7:37-38

#### Expect: His Greatness. Vv8b, 16-17

 You begin to realize more than ever that no sin or suffering is a match for His <u>redeeming</u> & <u>restoring</u> grace. Rom1:16; 2Pet1:3

Jesus came the 1<sup>st</sup> time to bear your judgment (Jn1:29). But if you reject Him, when you die (Heb9:27) or when He comes the 2<sup>nd</sup> time, you will face His judgment (vv16-17).

The absolutely best part of being a Christian is discovering & enjoying the presence & friendship of Jesus Christ. Ps25:14; Jn15:15

## **Growing Notes**

- 1) Read the introduction of this sermon about Satan. What are your thoughts? How important is it to know whether or not you are a Christian? What does it mean that salvation is a position where you REPENT & BELIEVE in a moment & maintain for the rest of your life?
- **2)** Read Luke 3:1-20. What stands out to you from this text? What is the overall tone? What was John's basic message (v3)? What Old Testament prophecy was fulfilled by John (v4)? What attitude did John warn the people not to have (vv8-9)? Why? How did the people respond (v10)? How did John describe Jesus (vv16-18)?
- **3)** Review the sermon notes under what it means to REPENT. What does it mean that if you change the root you'll change the fruit? What is changing the root & the fruit? Why is the order important: Trust 1<sup>st</sup> & Obey 2<sup>nd</sup>? What does it mean if a person says, "I'll obey God if..."?
- **4)** Review the sermon notes under what it means to BELIEVE. What does it mean to Enjoy His Goodness & Expect His Greatness? Why do you think that belief is more than just agreement with facts in the head about Christ but also an appetite for Him in the heart that exceeds all other appetites (Ps63:1)? Are you living in a position of repentance and belief in Jesus? Pray.
