"Darkness Creeping" Luke 22:35-71

Just as physical darkness can impair your vision, there is a spiritual darkness that can impair your spiritual vision (1Cor2:14; 2Cor4:4; Matt13:13). The incidents that happened in the physical dark (night time) in this text are going to show us how this condition of spiritual darkness can creep into our lives and what Jesus has come to do about it.

Darkness is Creeping In... v53

- ✓ When we are <u>sleepy</u> rather than <u>disciplined</u> about our habits of grace (Complacency). Vv39-40, 45-46; Rom12:11
- ✓ When we follow Christ from a <u>distance</u> and <u>warm ourselves</u> at the fires of this world rather than the fires of God's love (Compromise). Vv54-60; Ps1:1-3
- ✓ When God is a <u>means</u> to an end rather than the <u>end</u> (Collaboration with the enemy). Vv47-52; Job 1:9-11
- ✓ When we mock God rather than trust Him in suffering (Criticism/Cynicism). Vv63-71; 2Kings1; Luke18:32; Isa50:6

The Light of the Gospel of Christ Dispels Darkness... Vv35-38. 41-44

- ✓ Jesus took the ultimate darkness <u>for you</u> so that you could <u>live in the light</u> of the Gospel of Christ that will never go out. Luke 24:44; 2Cor5:21
- ✓ To the degree you believe it, is to the degree the darkness of your own heart will begin to lift. 2Cor.4:6; John 8:12
- ✓ Worldly repentance is sadness over the pain sin has caused me (Judas). Godly repentance is sadness over the pain sin has caused God (Peter). Luke 22:31-32; Vv61-62; 2Cor7:10-11; Rom2:4

Growing Notes

How does knowing that Jesus took the ultimate darkness for us eliminate complacency, compromise, collaborating with the enemy and criticism/cynicism? What is God speaking to you? What are your next proactive steps in keeping darkness from creeping into your life? Pray.
