Luke 24:36-53 "Unshakable 2018"



Growing Notes

- 3) Who does the Bible seem to be all about according to Jesus (vv44-45; Luke 23:25-27; John 5:39-40)? As followers of Christ what should we be busy doing (vv46-49)? What is the general atmosphere and attitude of those who encountered the resurrected Christ after His ascension (vv50-53)?
- 4) Review the five points (along with Bible verses) for becoming unshakable in 2018. Which one(s) are most convicting? Which one(s) are most captivating? Where are you in becoming more fully devoted to Jesus Christ: Genuine→Growing→Giving→Going→Glorifying? What are your next steps in becoming a more fully devoted follower of Jesus Christ in 2018? Pray.
