"Man/Woman Hood" 1Timothy 2:8-15

Our sexuality is not incidental, or unimportant, or a curse, or a burden. Our manhood and womanhood were created by the perfect love and infinite wisdom of our brilliant Father. When you own your manhood and womanhood through the clarifying lens of God's Word you bring God much glory and experience much joy.

God's Design for Men and Women:

- Men and women <u>are equal</u> in honor, worth and value. (Gen1:27-28; 1Pet3:7; Gal3:28)
- God designed men and women with <u>complementary roles</u> in the home (Eph5:21-33) and church (1Tim2:11-15) that reveal truths about Jesus.
- Men are to be <u>Servant Leaders</u> who provide and protect women in ways appropriate to a man's differing relationships. Woman are to be <u>Servant Lovers</u> who support and nurture leadership from worthy men in ways appropriate to a woman's differing relationships.

The Greatness of Womanhood: vv9-12

- <u>Modest</u> This is an undistracting attractiveness that is between idolizing and neglecting our bodies. True beauty is about love and not about looks. vv9-10; Isa53:2-3
- Quiet It is to not speak or behave in a way that undermines the authority. vv1, 11, 12
- <u>Teaching</u> Women should teach but not where it is exercising authority over men. v12; Titus 2:3; 2Tim1:5, 3:14; Acts 18:26; Matt28:19-20; Col 3:16; 1Cor 11
- <u>Submissive</u> Women are not to assume the office of elder in the church. vv11-12; 1Tim3:1-7, 5:17; Luke 22:26; 2Cor10:8; 1Pet5:3

"Authority" refers to the divine calling of spiritual, gifted men to take primary responsibility as elders for Christ-like servant-leadership and teaching in the church. (1Tim3; Titus1; 1Pet5)

<u>"Submission"</u> refers to the divine calling of the rest of the church, both men and women, to honor and affirm the leadership of the elders and to be equipped by it for the hundreds and hundreds of various ministries available to men and women in the service of Christ.

Why It's Loving and Wise to Follow God's Design: Vv13-15

- It is consistent with God's order of creation. v13; Gen2
- When God's order is rejected, it brings <u>disorder</u> and disintegration. v14; Gen3
- We were designed to know, love, and obey God supremely and when we are <u>faithful</u> to that design, we <u>flourish</u> even when life is hard. v15
