## "Bread of Life" (John 6:22-40)

I love homemade bread or rolls fresh out of the oven smothered with butter and drizzled with honey! That is certainly a gift from God and a pointer to the ultimate "Bread of Life" that is by far more sustaining and satisfying. People eat bread to satisfy physical hunger and to sustain physical life. This is why Jesus called Himself the "Bread of Life".

# BREAD OF LIFE: What Is It? vv22-27

- It is coming to Christ NOT as a <u>means</u> to an end but <u>the END</u>.
   vv25-26
- It is the pursuit of a <u>quality of life</u> that is eternal and freely given from Christ. v27; Jn.10:10b; Ps.25:14; Gal.5:22-23; Jer.9:23-24; Eccl.2:8-11 (NLT)

If you look to anything more than Christ for your quality of life... It will <u>Control</u> you when you seek it.
It will <u>Disappoint</u> you when you get. (Law of diminishing return)
And <u>Devastate</u> you when you lose it.

### How Do I Get It? vv28-29

- It is NOT something that I <u>achieve</u> but something I <u>receive</u>.
   vv28-29; Rom.3:20, 6:23; Eph.2:8-9
- It is truth about the person and work of Christ entering your <u>head</u> (content), igniting your <u>heart</u> (conviction/comfort), and outworking through your <u>hands</u> (commitment).
   Heb.11:1, 6; Jer.29:11, 13; Rom.10:17

#### Where Does it Come From? vv30-40

- It is available to <u>whoever</u>. (2 times in) v35
- It is an ongoing <u>intimate relationship</u> with Christ. v35
   Intimacy is mutual giving and receiving of <u>love</u> and <u>truth</u>.
- It is an inner gracious quiet spirit that <u>iovfully rests</u> in the presence and providence of Christ. vv36-40;
   Ps.23:1, 16:11; Gen.50:20

# **Growing Notes**

- People eat bread to satisfy physical hunger and to sustain life.
   What do you think it means when Jesus claims to be the Bread of Life (v35)?
- 2) Read **John 6:22-40.** Do an Observation (What does it say?), Interpretation (What does it mean?), and an Application (How do I apply this to my life?) of this text.
- 3) What is this Bread of Life (vv25-26)? What is the difference between Christ being a means to an end and being the end? Which one do you find yourself pursuing more: eternal or temporal quality of life? Explain.
- 4) How do you get this Bread of Life (**vv28-29)?** Is it something you achieve or receive? What is the work of God? What does it mean to believe in Christ?
- 5) Where does this Bread of Life come from **(v35)?** Who is it available to? What is an intimate relationship with Christ and what would be the results in your life? What is God speaking to you from this Bible study? Pray.
