**The orders need to be submitted by November 15**



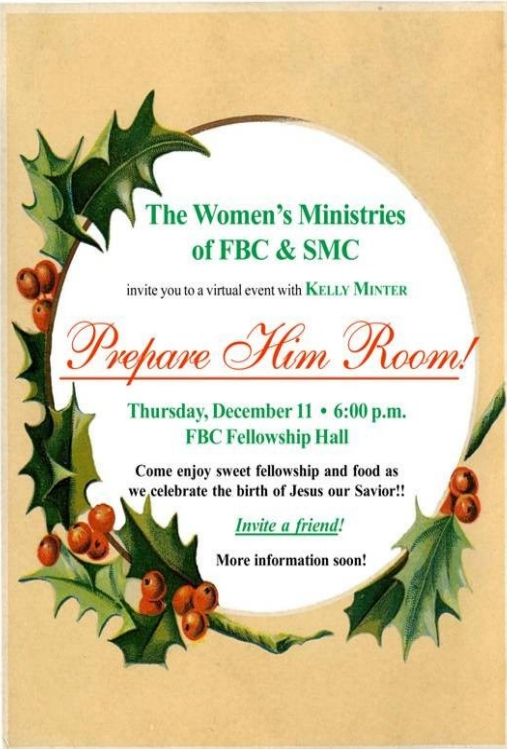
