



FORWARD Revisited

You may have noticed a few changes that have occurred at Family Bible Church as construction has begun. After more than fifteen years of discussion, prayer, and planning the building is being constructed. Recently, I shared with the site superintendent it still does not feel real to me. However, today I watched a team pouring footings for the foundation of the new building.

As the project progresses we invite you to continue to be involved in four different ways. First, stay up to date by reading the Weekly and/or checking the

construction update area on the temporary wall in the lobby and kids wing. Second, pray. Pray for wisdom for the building committee, safety for the workers and things to go to plan. Third, serve. Help will be needed this year and next with various projects. We want to have teams assembled and ready to serve. Please contact the office or David Mead to help. Fourth, give.

One year ago we introduced the FORWARD Campaign and it was an amazing success because of you! 120 households committed, \$760,900 was pledged over three years toward this project. We are thrilled to report over 48% have already come in! Most importantly 219 ONE's were identified and committed to. A ONE is someone not following Jesus, local to your context, and you rearrange your life to spend time with them (be and share Jesus).

Since the FORWARD Campaign Began (May 22'-May '23) against previous year (May '21-May '22) overall Sunday attendance is up 23%, children attendance is up 36% (nursery up 77%). Most importantly life change has occurred. In the last year we have witnessed 21 baptisms and 58 salvations and rededications. People coming to life in Jesus!

During the campaign last May we said we'd return to it one year later and many of you have received a letter and new pledge card from us in the mail recently.

We invite you to pray and identify your ONE again or for the first time. Maybe your ONE received Jesus, you will focus on a different ONE, or you will name a ONE for the first time.

We also invite you to make a financial commitment. Maybe you already pledged and need to decrease or increase your pledge. Maybe you did not pledge last May and want to be a new pledge. Maybe, nothing was being built, and you were waiting to see if it was going to happen, or you were new to FBC and still investigating or maybe you were not here at FBC.


The previous pledge (last May) and savings will get us more than halfway there for the total project cost. What if we could pay the building off in full and avoid longer debt? I'm trusting God to move through us at FBC and others in our community to pay this off ASAP.

If you'd like to learn more, we invite you to one of the two vision dessert nights we will host. They will be ninety minutes in length. These nights will give you an opportunity to better understand our vision (the why) and also be a part of a question and response time.
