1 Chronicles 4:9-10 **Jabez was more honorable than his brothers. His mother had named him Jabez, saying, "I gave birth to him in pain." 10 Jabez cried out to the God of Israel, "Oh, that you would bless me and enlarge my territory! Let your hand be with me, and keep me from harm so that I will be free from pain." And God granted his request.**

3 John 1:2 **Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers.**

Genesis 12:2 (NLT) **I will bless you...and you will be a blessing to others.**

2 Corinthians 10:15-16 (ESV) **But our hope is that as your faith increases, our area of influence among you may be greatly enlarged, so that we may preach the gospel in lands beyond you...**

**Ephesians 3:20 Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us.**

**Acts 11:21 The Lord's hand was with them and a great number of people believed and turned to the Lord.**

**2 Corinthians 3:5-6 Not that we are competent in ourselves to claim anything for ourselves, but our competence comes from God. He has made us competent as ministers of a new covenant—not of the letter but of the Spirit; for the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life.**

**1 Peter 5:8 Be alert and of sober mind. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour.**

**Psalm 3:1-3 Lord, how many are my foes! How many rise up against me! 2 Many are saying of me, "God will not deliver him." 3 But you, Lord, are a shield around me, my glory, the One who lifts my head high.**

**Romans 8:35-37 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall trouble or hardship or persecution or famine or nakedness or danger or sword? 36 As it is written: "For your sake we face death all day long; we are considered as sheep to be slaughtered." 37 No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us.**
