- 1. **Theology Proper** (Study of God the Father) Who is God? What has He done? Why did He do it? Who did He do it for? How is this good news?
- 2. **Christology** (Study of Jesus Christ) Who is Jesus? What has He done? Why did He do it? Who did He do it for? How is this good news?
- 3. **Pneumatology** (Study of the Holy Spirit) Who is the Holy Spirit? What has He done? Why did He do it? Who did He do it for? How is this good news?
- 4. **Anthropology** (Study of People) Who are we? What have we done? Why did we do it? What do we deserve?
- 5. **Angelology** (Study of Angels) Who are angels? What are they? Why does it matter? Who are demons? What are they? Who is the devil? What has he done? How does it affect me?
- 6. **Bibliology** (Study of the Bible) What is the Bible? How do you know? Why does it matter?
- 7. **Hamartiology** (Study of Sin) What is sin? Who has sinned? What are the effects of sin?
- 8. **Soteriology** (Study of Salvation) What is salvation? Why is it important? Who gets it? Who doesn't? Where does it come from? How do we know? Why does it matter?
- 9. **Ecclesiology** (Study of the Church) What is the church? Who is it made up of? Where does it come from? What does it do? Why does it matter?
- 10. **Missiology** (Study of Mission) What do I do now? How does it change my everyday life? Why does it matter?
- 11. **Eschatology** (Study of the End Times) What happens at the end of time? How do we know? When is it? Where will we be? Why does it matter?
