1. **Theology Proper** (Study of God the Father) - Who is God? What has He done? Why did He do it? Who did He do it for? How is this good news?
2. **Christology** (Study of Jesus Christ) - Who is Jesus? What has He done? Why did He do it? Who did He do it for? How is this good news?
3. **Pneumatology** (Study of the Holy Spirit) - Who is the Holy Spirit? What has He done? Why did He do it? Who did He do it for? How is this good news?
4. **Anthropology** (Study of People) - Who are we? What have we done? Why did we do it? What do we deserve?
5. **Angelology** (Study of Angels) - Who are angels? What are they? Why does it matter? Who are demons? What are they? Who is the devil? What has he done? How does it affect me?
6. **Bibliology** (Study of the Bible) - What is the Bible? How do you know? Why does it matter?
7. **Hamartiology** (Study of Sin) - What is sin? Who has sinned? What are the effects of sin?
8. **Soteriology** (Study of Salvation) - What is salvation? Why is it important? Who gets it? Who doesn't? Where does it come from? How do we know? Why does it matter?
9. **Ecclesiology** (Study of the Church) - What is the church? Who is it made up of? Where does it come from? What does it do? Why does it matter?
10. **Missiology** (Study of Mission) - What do I do now? How does it change my everyday life? Why does it matter?
11. **Eschatology** (Study of the End Times) - What happens at the end of time? How do we know? When is it? Where will we be? Why does it matter?
