

FAMILY DISCUSSION


- Where did people come from to talk to Jesus?
- What kind of seed/grain did Jesus talk about?
- What did Jesus say yes to?
- Read John 12:32. Who did Jesus say would be drawn to Jesus if Jesus was lifted up?
- What is something God wants you to say yes to this week?
- Is it difficult for you to say yes to God's plan when you're not completely sure what it is?
- What is something you will do this week because you said yes to God's plan?

FAMILY ACTIVITY: YOUR YES!



Print and cut this week's printable and hand one out to each kid.

On the back of the card, tell kids to write something that they are going to say yes to this week.

These things may be hard to do, but they can do it because of love (e.g., help around the house, give someone a genuine compliment, make someone smile).

After they have written their idea down, play twenty questions using only yes or no questions only to guess what they wrote!

There are a lot of things we can do to say yes to. But remember you can't just say yes – you need to follow through with action. Jesus said yes to God's plans then obeyed God every step of the way.

We can follow Jesus' example and say yes to God's plans for us!
