Wisdomland - God can help you make the wise choice

DAY 1

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DAY 2

Read 1 Kings 3:4-15

Imagine you're at Wisdomland, a super cool theme park. You have a special pass to ask for anything to make your day awesome. Would you ask for unlimited candy? Unlimited rides? No waiting lines?

When Solomon became king, God appeared in a dream and said, "Ask for anything." Solomon could have asked for wealth, fame, or to defeat enemies. But he asked for wisdom! He knew being a good leader meant making wise choices. God was pleased and gave him wisdom, wealth, and honor!

Like Solomon, we can ask God for wisdom. It's like asking for the ultimate guide through life's ups and downs. God wants to give it to you!

If God told you right now, "Ask for anything," what would you ask for and why?

DAY 3

Read Proverbs 15:1; 3:5-6; 17:17

Think about your friendships. What makes a good friend? Kindness, trust, and loyalty. Did you know wisdom is like a really good friend?

God gave Solomon amazing wisdom, and we see it in Proverbs. Proverbs 15:1 teaches that a gentle answer calms anger. Proverbs 3:5-6 reminds us to trust God with all our heart. Proverbs 17:17 says a true friend loves at all times. Wisdom helps us be that kind of friend.

God wants to the best for you! He wants to give you wisdom for every part of your life.

DAY 4

Read Proverbs 16:1-16

God wants to give us strong wisdom! Proverbs 16:16 says: "It is much better to get wisdom than gold...understanding than silver." Wisdom is more valuable than any treasure! How can you find more wisdom? Spend time in God's Word, the Bible. Solomon wrote many wise sayings in Proverbs!

DAY 5

Read James 1

James 1:5 says: "If any of you needs wisdom, you should ask God for it. He will give it to you. God gives freely to everyone and doesn't find fault" (NIrV). When you ask for wisdom, God can give you a new idea, direction, or peace. He can also give you wisdom through others who follow Jesus.

Ask God for wisdom anytime you need to make a tough choice. He's always ready to help!

Today, thank God for giving wisdom, you can pray something like this. "Dear God, thank You for giving me wisdom. Like Solomon, I know I can't do things on my own. Please give me wisdom to make wise choices today and every day. Help me trust in You and look to Your Word. Thank you for always being with me and giving me the wisdom I need. I love You. In Jesus' name, Amen."
