
Read: Daniel 6:22 NIrV



Window Prayers

Even though Daniel was told not to pray to God. Daniel still opened his window toward Jerusalem and talked with God. Remember, you can talk to God anywhere, anytime, just like Daniel.

Inside the window, draw yourself praying!

Lion Shadows

Daniel was put in a den with hungry lions. It was dark, and Daniel probably felt scared and alone. But Daniel wasn't alone! God sent an angel to keep him safe all night. Daniel knew God was right beside him, even when he couldn't see Him.

When you feel alone...at bedtime, at school, or playing outside, remember, you're never really alone. God is right there with you, too, even if you can't see Him.

KNOW God is always beside you! He is strong, loving, and always watching over you.

Roar of Courage

Daniel talked to God every single day, so trusting Him felt natural, even when hungry lions growled nearby. Good habits, like praying before breakfast, singing a worship song in the car, or thanking God at night, help you remember He's with you. When worries roar, lean on God!

Build a cozy blanket "den." Sit inside with a friend or sibling. Each of you should share a way God helped you, then roar together, "God is with us!"

ASK someone you know to give an example of when they talk to God.



Safe and Sound

At sunrise, King Darius hurried to the den and called out to Daniel to see if he was okay. Daniel replied, "God shut the lions' mouths!" The same God is with you when you are scared riding the bus and whispers courage during shots at the doctor. God is with you everywhere.

THANK God for being with you, always!

Morning Time

Meal Time

At a meal this week, have everyone at the table answer this question: "Think about something that makes you scared or anxious. How would the way you see or feel about it change if you remembered that God is always with you?"



Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: "When do you feel the most alone? When do you feel the least alone?"



Bed Time

Pray for each other: "God, sometimes it's hard to remember that You are always with us. Help us to never forget. Remind us that You never leave us."
