Review: Living a Romans 12 life requires a Romans 12 love!
Big Idea: A Romans 12 love involves
How Do You Relate to Those Who Hurt You?
• Take the high road by Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse. Rejoice with those who rejoice; mourn with those who mourn. Live in harmony with one another. Do not be proud, but be willing to associate with people of low position. Do not be conceited Roman 12:14-16 (NIV)
We bless those who persecute us by showing:

• Take the high road by Do not repay anyone evil for evil. Be careful to do what is right in the eyes of everybody. If it is possible, as far as it depends on y live at peace with everyoneRomans 12:17-18 (NIV)
• Take the high road by Do not take revenge, my friends, but leave room for God's wrath, for it is written: "It is mine to avenge; I will repay," says the Lord On the contrary: "If your enemy is hungry, feed him; if he is thirsty, give him something to drink. In doing this, you will heap burning coals on his head." Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good Romans 12:19-21 (NIV)
