WHAT IS THE PROJECT?

Writing encouraging letters of support for community leaders. This is a non-political support. Rather, it should have emphasis on encouragement and prayer during these difficult times where spot of the moment changes have had to occur. Examples: President, Congressional Leaders, Governor, State Representatives, Local County/ Municipal Leaders, Health Department Leaders, School administration and or teachers, local fire/ems/police departments, etc.

HOW MANY PEOPLE CAN DO THIS PROJECT? - 3+

LOCATION OF THE PROJECT

This can be done anywhere, even at home on an individual basis or collectively during a group night.

BEST TIME/SEASON TO DO THE PROJECT

Anytime of the year.

THE PURPOSE OF THE PROJECT

To positively encourage community leaders.

SUPPLIES NEEDED

- Computer and printer, or pen and paper
- Envelopes
- Stamps

STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS

1. Formulate a list of people to whom the letters will be sent.
2. Write or type the letters.
3. Print the letters if applicable.
4. Place the letters into the envelopes.
5. Address the letters to the community leaders whom you are writing.
6. Place the correct postage stamps on the envelopes.
7. Place the letters in the outgoing mail or drop off at the post office.
