- 1. Who has been the most influential female in your life? And, why?
- 2. What do you think today's middle-class American culture thinks about women?
- 3. How is that different from other parts of the world today? Or, in Jesus day?
- 4. Men; how have you made efforts to treat women as equals?
- 5. Women; how have you been made to feel less than an equal?
- 6. Read 1 Peter 3:7, Galatians 3:28, Luke 10:38-39. How did Jesus treat women himself and want others to treat them? (with honor, dignity, respect, as equal heirs to the Kingdom, and with compassion)
- 7. There are significant times in God's overall story of redemption that women show up as key participants. What are some?
 - 1. He chose a woman (Mary) to begin his process of redeeming mankind.
 - 2. He performed his first miracle at the behest of his mom (Mary)
 - 3. Women traveled with him and supported his ministry, Luke 8:1-3. (Mary Magdalene, Joanna, Suzanna)
 - 4. The sinful woman at the well. John 4:4-26.
 - 5. The woman caught in adultery. Jesus teaches a valuable lesson about equality in God's eyes and about forgiveness. John 8:7
 - 6. Women were the first to see the empty tomb. Matthew 27:61.
