ICEBREAKER QUESTION

WATCH THE TEACHING VIDEO BY PASTOR KEVIN KELLOGG

NOT COMING DOWN - OF ETERNAL IMPORTANCE (Scripture: Nehemiah 6:3, John 3:1-21, Matthew 28:19-20)

- 1. Other than church, what institutions do you belong to? Clubs, civic groups, alumni groups, etc?
- 2. How do you participate in those? Or, what is your role?
- 3. How do you know if those institutions/groups are doing a good job?
- 4. Read Nehemiah 6:3. Why will Nehemiah not come down?
- 5. Just like Nehemiah got orders from his King, what are our orders and who do they come from? (Matthew 28:19-20)
- 6. Why are these orders so important? (there are eternal consequences)
- 7. Describe the opposition when an organization makes movements forward. (people don't like change, some are too comfortable where they are, some don't agree with the direction, people know it will take time, resources and energy, etc.)
- 8. Read John 3:1-21. Why do you think Jesus was so direct with Nicodemus?
- 9. Describe a direct conversation you've had with someone about their eternal destiny. (here's a great article to share with your group members: https://billygraham.org/story/sharing-your-faith-101/)
- 10. It was said in the weekend message that all people will spend eternity somewhere, the question is where. Do you know where those in your circles of influence will spend eternity?
- 11. Knowing that, what will you do about it?

ACTION STEP

The action step out of the weekend message was to consider how much you care about the future of Grace Fellowship church. Do you care enough to serve, give, participate, sacrifice and take some ownership of your church?

SHEPHERDING / CARE / PRAYER

One of the ways you can shepherd your group members is to make sure you know if they are attending church regularly. We are seeing a drop in regular attendance, and it isn't healthy for those who call themselves Christians, and especially for group members. People aren't leaving the church, but people are attending less regular. Worship attendance once or twice a month just isn't healthy for the person or the community of believers. So, make sure you know and are moving your people toward increased attendance.
