- Collaborate with Production Director for vision and execution of leading production volunteers
- Own ministry production support for campus-specific events at Upper Arlington
- Lead from the stage 3 out of 4 times a month
- Shepherd and lead music and production volunteers in cooperation with WST staff
- Keep spaces clean and instruments/systems maintained
- Review each weekend service and provide feedback to band/production teams and connect to development opportunities
- Represent the weekend services team in campus staff meetings and in collaboration with campus-specific events
- Assist with overall departmental needs and special projects as needed
- Other duties as assigned
