- 2. Who has been a positive male role model in your life? Why?
- 3. Read **Genesis 2:15-20**. What does man's role look like after viewing these verses?
- 4. Read 1 Peter 3:7. In the passage men are instructed to live "considerately" or "with understanding" with their wives. For men: what does this mean in your life right now? For women: what would "considerate" or "with understanding" look like for you?
- 5. How does understanding that men and women are different—but equal—affect how you view relationships and responsibilities?
- 6. Identify one of those differences above. How can awareness of this difference improve your interactions with the opposite gender?
- 7. Our sermon notes mention, "Standing up as a man begins with kneeling before the Lord." What does that look like practically?
- 8. Many men oscillate between apathy and aggression. Why do you think this happens? How can God's design redirect that pattern?
- 9. How did Jesus succeed where Adam failed?
- 10. For men: In what ways can you model Jesus' strength in your family, workplace, or friendships? For women: how can you help in supporting these roles with your own?
